Evergrain® complies with the globally recognised AAMA2604 standard and Australian standard AS3715.



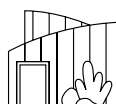

How it works

Evergrain® is a multi-layered powder-coated finish.

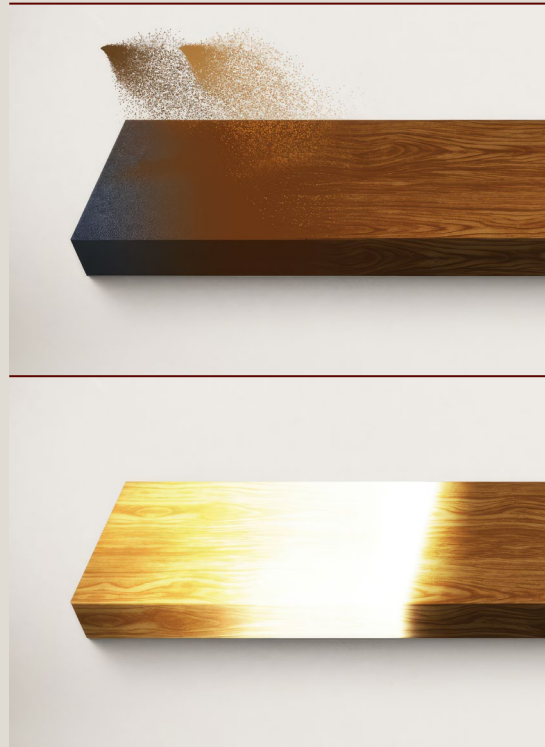
The powder coating is applied in two stages: base coat and grain pattern, known as POP – Powder on Powder.

The initial base coat is applied using the same process as regular powder coating, then partially heat cured.

The second grain-pattern coat is applied using a unique powder coating process.

The profile is then fully cured, and the two powders are fused to create a single textured coating.

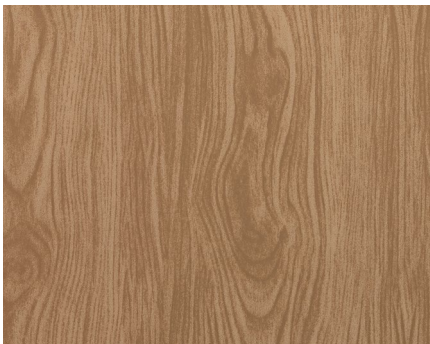
The result is the natural look and feel of real timber.

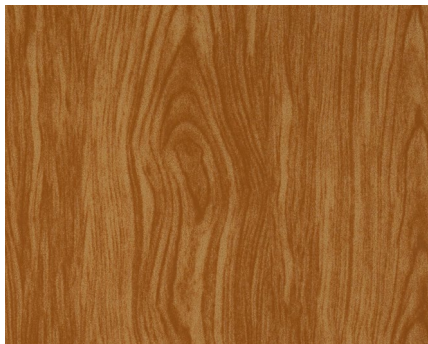

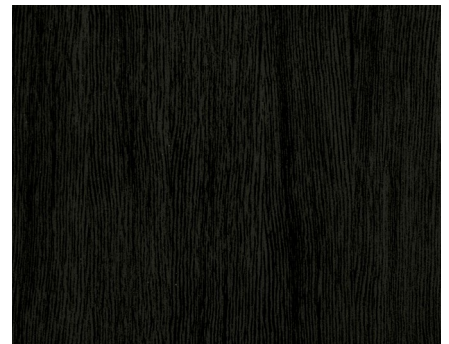

The sandy warm-neutral tones of Australian Beech.



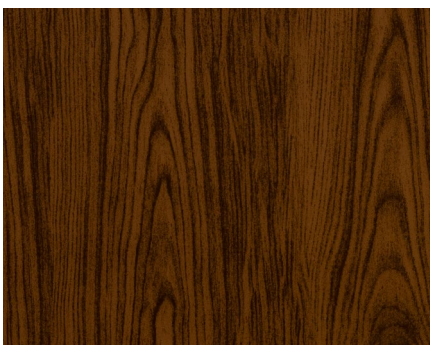
AAF GOLDEN OAK

A pale golden palette that resembles the Australian Blackbutt timber species.



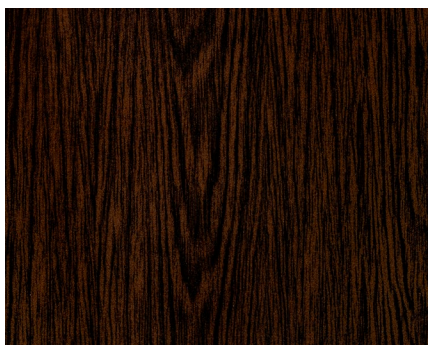
AAF BLACKWOOD

The very dark tones of blackened or charred timber.



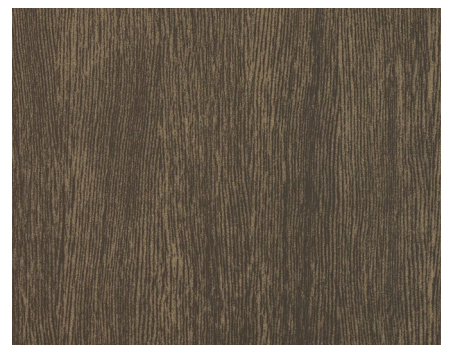

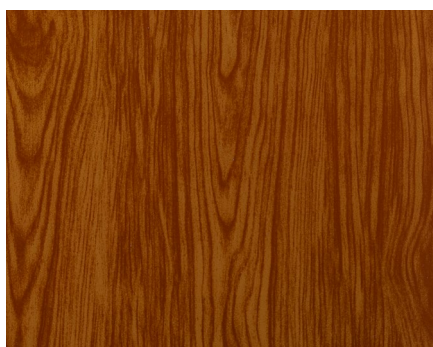
The dark brown and chocolate tones of English Oak.

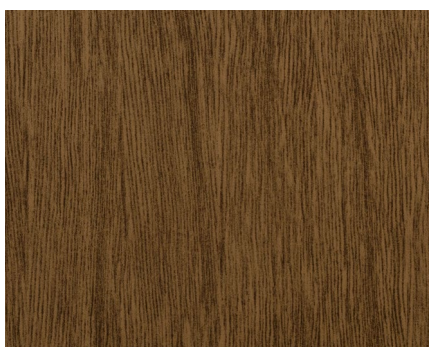
A grey-brown palette that evokes timber aged by seawater.

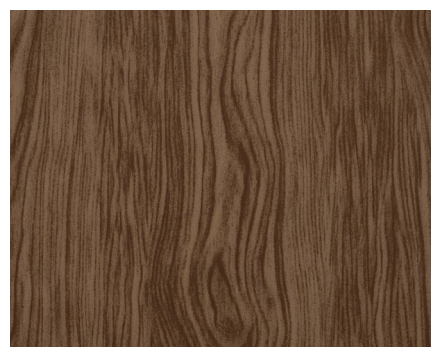

The rich warm-red colouring of Hazelnuts.



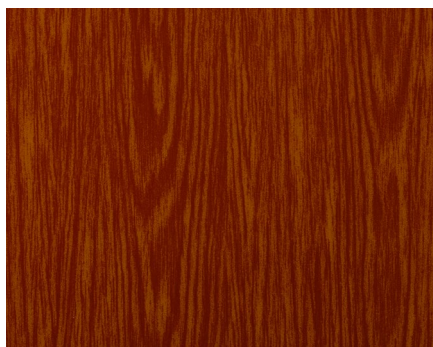

The natural mid-brown tones of Australian Spotted Gum.



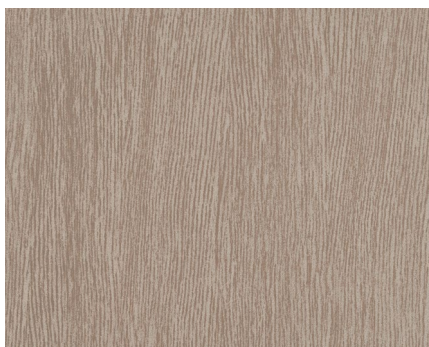

A rich brown palette that resembles native Australian Walnut.



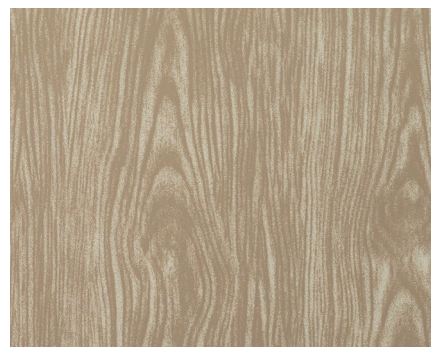
